

# DEPARTMENT C – FASHION SHOW

## Department C-Fashion Show Division 410

4-H Staff Person Responsible – Cathy Raneri

- A. Any 4-H member including Clover Kids enrolled in a clothing project may enter the fashion show.
- B. All exhibitors must exhibit garments at the fair **and** model at the Public Fashion Show at the fairgrounds to claim ribbons and premiums for the Fashion Show. Fashion Show Judging will be held on Tuesday July 14, 2009 at the central office from 12:30 - 7:00 pm. Registration is required to reserve a judging time. To enter the Fashion Show, fill out Form C-Fashion Show Narrative. This form is available on-line at [www.4hgetgreen.org](http://www.4hgetgreen.org) and must be returned to the central or south office by Thursday, July 2, 2009. Any registrations received after this date will be lowered one ribbon placing. No late registrations will be accepted after July 9. NO EXCEPTIONS.
- C. Models for the 2009 Fashion Show may model up to two items for judging during fashion show judging day but will only model ONE outfit for the public fashion show at the Sarpy County Fair. 4-H'ers may model only 1 outfit per division. Two outfits is the maximum number of modeling entries for fashion show judging day. If a 4-H'er is modeling 2 outfits for fashion show judging day, they MUST indicate on Form C when it is turned in, which outfit will be modeled at the public fashion show. Garments need to be age appropriate.
- D. Clover Kids may model on judging day and at the public fashion show if they have a wearable item such as a Decorate Your Duds clothing item, a clothing project from Sewing for Fun or a Sewing Level 1 project. Pillows, throws, hair accessories, shoe laces or other items not considered a wearable garment will not be modeled.
- E. Judging of all models will take place on Tuesday, July 15 at the central office, 8015 West Center Road, between 12:30 and 7 p.m. There will be no judging during the public fashion show and no alternate date. Judging times are scheduled and must be pre-registered for. Those participating will be notified of their judging time by email.
- F. The **Public Fashion Show** will be held during the Sarpy County Fair on Wednesday, July 29, 2009 at 6 p.m. at the Sarpy County Fairgrounds in Springfield, NE.
- G. All models chosen for State Fair must be 10 years old by January 1, 2009.
- H. Fashion Show premiums are pay level 5.

**CLASS 10      DECORATE YOUR DUDS:**  
Garment Constructed from an Original Designed Fabric. Fabric is made first, then a garment is constructed from the fabric. Examples include: painting on fabric, color discharge, shibori tie dyeing, weaving fabric strips, crazy piecing and paper piecing, and color blocking fabric pieces. Other embellishments may be added. Embellished garment with original design entries and textile clothing accessory entries are NOT accepted.

**CLASS 20      CLOTHING LEVEL 2:**  
4-H members who have enrolled in or who have completed Sewing for You or Tailoring projects are not eligible. A purchased top can be worn to complete a vest or jacket outfit with a skirt, pants or shorts. Nightshirts, flannel lounging pants or any other type of loungewear cannot be modeled.  
Possible types of garments include Dress; Skirted Outfit (skirt with shirt, vest or jacket OR jumper and shirt; Pants Outfit (pants with shirt, vest or jacket or jogging outfit); OR Shorts Outfit (shorts with shirt, vest or jacket or jogging outfit).

**CLASS 30      SEWING FOR YOU**  
Nightwear or loungewear can NOT be modeled. Dress; Skirted Outfit (skirt with shirt, vest, or jacket OR jumper and shirt); Formal (dress or tuxedo for prom, wedding or other formal occasion); Pants Outfit (pants or shorts with shirt, vest, or jacket); Specialty Wear (costume); Sportswear (jogging outfit, swim wear, aerobic wear, or ski wear); Coat/Outerwear/Jacket (lined or unlined, non-tailored); OR Western Wear (chaps, chinks, or riding attire).

**CLASS 40      TAILORING**  
Additional pieces with blazer, jacket or coat may either be constructed or purchased. Tailored Blazer, Suit Jacket, or Coat

**CLASS 901\*      CLOVER KIDS**  
Decorate Your Duds Clothing

**CLASS 902\*      SEWING FOR FUN**  
Simple clothing article (no pattern)

**CLASS 903\*      CLOTHING LEVEL 1**  
A purchased garment may be worn with a constructed garment to create a complete wearable outfit. If the 4-H'er wears two constructed garments, such as skirt and top, the member must indicate on the entry form which garment is to be judged at the Fashion Show.

**CLASS 904\*      DECORATE YOUR DUDS**  
Embellishment applied to a purchased garment.

**CLASS 905\*      ATTENTION SHOPPERS**  
Wearable outfit that can be purchased and/or assembled from present wardrobe with purchased additions.

- CLASS 906\***    **MAKE ONE-BUY-ONE**  
A purchased garment with a constructed garment(s) to make a complete wearable outfit to show wardrobe planning skills.
- CLASS 907\***    **RECYCLED GARMENT**  
Article of clothing made from another garment(s).
- CLASS 908\***    **KNITTED OR CROCHETED GARMENT**  
From middle or advanced unit.
