

## DEPARTMENT Z – SHOOTING SPORTS

If a project is not eligible for the State Fair, but can be entered at the Sarpy County Fair (most beginning level projects), the requirements for entries will be listed in the 2009 Sarpy County Fair Book. Information for projects that are eligible for State Fair AND Sarpy County Fair can be found in the 2009 State Fair Book. The fair pages are listed by department. Pre-Registration not necessary

To participate in these competitions, a 4-H'er **MUST** have been enrolled in the County Shooting Sports Club during the current year and **MUST** have attended at least 4 previous Shooting Sports sessions since June 1, 2008 to be eligible to compete. Any shooter acting in an unsafe manner will be disqualified. Unsportsmanlike actions shall be reason for disqualification. Persons accompanying the participants, acting in an inappropriate manner, may get the participant disqualified.

Air Rifles are defined as the description in the national air rifle book. Scopes will not be allowed! The club's air rifles will be available for use if desired on a first come basis. Targets will be shot at 10 meters (32'9"). Air Rifles are available from the club if needed. The following rules for firearms brought to the fair:

1. They meet the specific criteria mentioned in the definition above.
2. All firearms be clean and in good working condition.
3. A responsible adult must bring each firearm in a case or box straight from the vehicle to the range, check in immediately, and following the competition, return straight to the car.
4. Each firearm will be marked with the member's name with tape on the stock.

### **Shooting Times At the Fair Grounds:**

Sunday, August 2 at 1:00 p.m. in the Livestock Barn

We will have 2 age groups this year.  
Junior 9-12 years old and Senior 13-18 years old.  
(This is your age as of January 1, 2009.)

Trophies will be awarded to first place in each age group for both Archery and Air Rifle, Ribbons for all other places.

### Archery:

You must use the club equipment we own, do not bring your own equipment.

This will be bare bow shooting, no sights, stabilizers, release mechanisms or other accessories.

Scoring will follow the FITA standard adapted for our youth targets. X,10,9,8,7,6,5,4,3 points from center out on the 40cm target.

25 additional points will be awarded based on safety, proper procedure and following range commands.

Youth will shoot 2 ends of 5 arrows from 12 yards.

Seniors will shoot 2 ends of 5 arrows from 25 yards.

If required, ties will be broken by counting X's or an additional end of 5 arrows.

Arrow "Bounce-outs" will be reshot.

If an archer shoots too many arrows, he will be penalized by pulling and not scoring his highest scoring arrow.

Any arrow shot into the target of another archer is to receive no score but counts as a shot arrow.

Air Rifle:

1. You may use the club equipment or your own equipment. Open sights only, no scopes. Spotting scopes allowed.

2. Please bring a mat or blanket to lay on for the prone position. No braces, supports or other shooting aids.

3. Shooters will use .177 pellets.

4. Targets Sets will be the 12 target type (2 sighting targets). One shot per target, Scoring shall be Center Point, 8,7,6,5,4,3,2,1.

5. One Target Set per position.

6. Target sighting will be 5 shots in five minutes for each position.

7. Shooting 10 shots from 10 meters prone position and 10 shots from 10 meters standing position. 10 additional points will be awarded based on safety, proper procedure and following range commands.

Targets will be signed by the participant in the presence of the range officer.
