



**FCS Web Quiz
Online Registration Instructions
2009**

This quiz is a multiple-choice test based on Family and Consumer Sciences subject matter. The following 4-H manuals were used for this years quiz and can be checked out from your local county Extension office:

- Sewing For Fun
- Youth in Motion
- Becoming Money Wise Levels I & II
- Road to Good Cooking
- The Sitter
- ESI: Discover the E-Scene

This quiz is designed for you to take by yourself. To be fair to everyone, please do not ask anyone else for help and put your manuals away before you take this quiz. By doing this, you will find out what information **you** know and what areas you need to work on. You may only take this quiz once.

This quiz has been designed for 8 to 12 year old youth. However, anyone can take it. The following directions will take you through the process. You can take the quiz anytime from April 29, 2009 to August 1, 2009. You will have 60 minutes to complete the quiz.

Once you get to the website (<http://calculus.unl.edu/edu/classes/fcs4h/>) you will need to register to be able to take the quiz. The following are directions on how to do so. You may want to print these off.

1. First you will want to click on “Register as a student in this class”. This is found on the right hand side of the page. This will take you to a screen where you are asked to enter your name, a username, password, etc.

In order to work assignments for credit, you need to register with the system. To do this, please fill out the information requested in the form below. Required fields are marked with *. When you have completed the form, click OK at the top of the page.

* Name: 1-25 characters, letters only, but hyphens and apostrophes may be used (e.g. Smith-Klein, O'Brian)
* First MI * Last

* Login name: 3 to 9 characters, letters and numbers only

* Password: 5 to 12 characters, letters and numbers only

* Student ID #: **Do not use your SSN.** Use your 8-digit NUID or your school assigned student ID (8 digit max).

Email address: Forgetful? If you include your email address, the system can use it to remind you of your login info.

2. Follow the instructions and enter your first and last name
3. Create a username (login). This should be something you can remember, such as your name or a nickname.
4. Create and reenter your password
5. In the space where it says Student ID #, please enter the number one (1) and your phone number (without area code). You do not need to include dashes.
6. Please enter your email address at the bottom. If you don't have an email address, leave it blank or enter your parent's email address (with their permission).

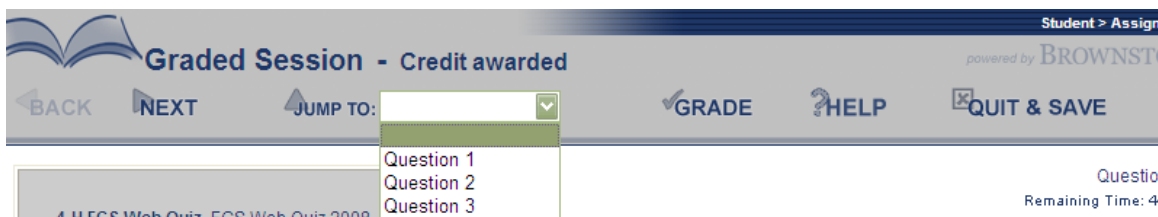

7. Hit OK.
8. A new page will come up to verify the information you have just entered. If everything is correct, hit Yes, if not, hit No and change your information.
9. After this step you will be directed back to the homepage. You are now ready to take the FCS quiz!
10. On the menu, select 2009 FCS Web Quiz.
11. You will be asked to enter the username and password you have just created. After doing so, hit ok to enter the quiz.
12. You will then be directed to a page which asks you if you want to take the quiz online or print out a copy. Click on “Work Assignment Online, right now”.



13. The quiz consists of 25 questions, with each question being worth 4 points. Read through each question and select the best answer. There is only one correct answer for each question. Once you have answered the questions on the page, select NEXT from the menu at the top of the page in the upper left hand corner. If you need to go back to a question, hit the BACK button on the top of your page. You can also use the JUMP TO pull down menu to move from page to page.

14. After all 25 questions have been answered; the NEXT button will not be available, so select the GRADE option to have your quiz graded. The computer will grade your quiz and show you the score you have received on the grade report. If you would like to see your results, you may do so by selecting the VIEW DETAILS button in the top menu. This will show you which questions you answered correctly and the correct answer (if you answered a questions incorrectly).
15. When you are done looking at your results, you can QUIT and SAVE. This will take you to a screen where you can simply shut the browser window.
16. Congratulations on completing the quiz! You will be receiving a ribbon for your efforts from your local extension office. Your ribbon will be based on your total quiz score; this is the number at the bottom of the “Points Earned” column of the Grade Report. Ribbons will be awarded as follows:

| <u>Points</u> | <u>Ribbon</u> |
|---------------|---------------|
| 88-100 | Purple |
| 76-87 | Blue |
| 64 -75 | Red |
| Below 64 | White |

*** If you happen to be logged out of the quiz (this happens if the quiz is idle for 12 minutes) or if you are disconnected from the Internet, you can restart the quiz by going back to step #9. Once you are logged back on, you will have the option to continue the quiz.***
