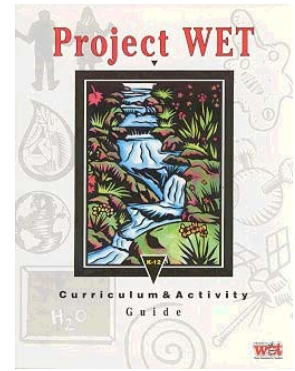




You are invited to attend a training to improve your Conservation Education Skills
